Dear Artist:

The New Milford Historical Society is proud to celebrate our wonderful New England town with this special art show. You may enter original work that has not been entered in a previous show at our museum. We welcome artists at all levels. Your work must feature recognizable structures, scenes, or events in New Milford. Paintings using different mediums, photographs, and hand-built models or sculptures may be submitted for consideration. You do not need to be a New Milford resident to participate in this art show. There is no entry fee, but if you chose to sell your piece, NMHS will take 20% of your declared value. If you have cards or prints of *the entered piece only* that you wish to sell, our museum store will sell them for 20% profit as well. In an effort to defray program printing costs, we invite you to enter your contact information in our program at the price of \$25 for a quarter page ad. Sponsors who donate \$100 for a full page ad will be listed on our website and banner advertising the event. All artists and their guests are invited to an opening reception on Friday, September 21st from 6 to 8 pm. Please come and mingle!

Gallery space is limited, therefore certain restrictions apply:

- **wall art must be framed and wire hung; no sawtooth hangers**
- **wall art is limited to an area totaling 100 square inches, including frame; this gives you the opportunity to submit multiple works of art**
- **models or sculptures must fit on an 18 X 18 pedestal**

NMHS will exercise the same care with your art as it does with its own property. NMHS will insure all objects under its insurance policy against risks of physical loss or damage while in the museum during the show. Insurance will be placed in the amount specified by the artist, which must reflect fair market value. In case of damage or loss, the insurance company may ask the artist to substantiate the insurance value. NMHS reserves the right to photograph, videotape, or reproduce the work for documentation, publicity, and educational purposes. Credit will be given to the lender in any labels and publications in conjunction with this exhibit. Delivery and pick up of loaned work is the responsibility of the artist.

Drop off dates: Thursday, 9/6 from 10 am to 4 pm and Saturday, 9/8 from 11 am to 2 pm. Pick up dates: Sunday, 10/21 from 11 am to 2 pm, or during scheduled hours the museum is open that week.
